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## AMP Announces 2023 Fair Schedule

**New York, New York**— A testament to its longevity and leadership in the art world, [Art Market Productions \(AMP\)](#) announces the exciting schedule for its upcoming 2023 fair line-up, inclusive of **Art Market San Francisco, Seattle Art Fair, Art Market Hamptons, and Art on Paper**. Now entering its second decade, the prolific company behind some of the country's leading and longest-running art fairs delivers high-quality live art experiences that speak to artists, galleries, collectors, and art lovers alike. With esteemed female leadership, including **Director Kelly Freeman**, at the helm, the 2023 editions promise to be bigger and better than ever.

Speaking of the close-knit arts community, AMP is delighted to announce the expansion of **Nato Thompson's** role. The high-profile creative director, who will return as Seattle Art Fair's creative director for a fourth year, will now take on an expanded role as AMP's Creative Director for Art Market San Francisco and Art on Paper as well. In doing so, Thompson will curate stimulating large-scale art installations & activations while also creating inspiring, integrated programming. A self-described "cultural infrastructure builder," he comes to the fairs with a robust curatorial background, including a decade-long tenure overseeing projects at Creative Time and providing artistic direction for Philadelphia Contemporary and MASS MoCA.

Despite a global pandemic and market swings, AMP has proven itself as a leader in producing and promoting their roster of premier art fairs. Its tried and true methods have created a culture of collaboration second to none, solidifying and strengthening relationships among artists, galleries, and the local art scenes in which each of their fairs live. The company is constantly evolving, as evident by the new look and feel of its fairs for 2023, new website launches, but has always maintained a large lens into the communities and cities served through their unique platform, which has seen hundreds of thousands of visitors in attendance over the last decade.

Since its inception, AMP has been a trailblazer in the space, infiltrating and integrating communities to assess the needs of artists, galleries, dealers, collectors, and art enthusiasts. By doing so, each fair has an authentic voice unique to that community, representative of its wishes, and reflective of the imagination of the city's creatives. It is AMP's authentic approach that has led to the expansion of each fair's footprint, keeping everyone coming back year after year: Art Market San Francisco returns for its 11th iteration; Seattle Art Fair enters its seventh year; Art Market Hamptons will be back for its 13th edition, and Art on Paper will continue to showcase unique and powerful projects at its ninth fair.

- **Art Market San Francisco**, the Bay Area's longest-running art fair, returns to **Fort Mason's Festival Pavilion, April 20–23, 2023**, with 85 top galleries from around the world and a program of Public Projects curated by Thompson to celebrate the vibrant, experimental, and inclusive

strength that defines the Bay Area's thriving arts community, renowned as an international arts destination.

- **Seattle Art Fair**, a one-of-a-kind showcase for the vibrant arts community of the Pacific Northwest and a leading destination for the best in modern and contemporary art, returns to the **Lumen Field Event Center** for its seventh edition, **July 27–30, 2023**. Working alongside Beneficiary Partner Seattle Art Museum, Thompson, and the fair's dedicated Host Committee, the Seattle Art Fair, founded by the late Paul G. Allen, is a celebrated and productive week bringing together top local, national and international galleries along with the region's strong collector base, the Pacific Northwest's top museums and institutions.
- **Art Market Hamptons**, the East End's premier, and longest-running art fair, will take place from **August 10-13, 2023**. Known for its museum-quality design, compelling gallery presentations, and the region's unique buying power, Art Market Hamptons has long been a window into a dedicated community of East End collectors. The event will feature a strong showing of local stalwart galleries that have defined the region for the past few decades, alongside engaging and enthralling collections from national and international modern and contemporary dealers. Well curated with strong sales, the celebrated fair is the highlight of the Hamptons Summer Season and a cultural cornerstone produced in partnership with the region's leading art institutions.
- **Art on Paper**, New York City's celebrated, medium-driven fair, returns to downtown Manhattan's **Pier 36** from **September 7–10, 2023**, during Armory Arts Week. With 100 galleries featuring top modern and contemporary paper-based art, Art on Paper continues to bring about thought-provoking projects and create meaningful connections among museum curators, directors, and sophisticated private collectors. These visual, experiential moments have set the fair apart and established Art on Paper as a quintessential destination for the arts in New York City. Thompson, will curate the fair's ninth edition with a focus on "can't miss" performances and programming highlighting the creative potential of paper. As in past editions, much more than just prints and drawings will be on view at Pier 36's spacious museum-like location. This year will also welcome back the Lower Eastside Girls Club as an official partner.
