Art on Paper's 8th Edition Closes With Strong Sales

New York, New York -- [Art on Paper](#) returned to downtown **Manhattan's Pier 36** this past weekend, with strong sales from an invigorated attendance of art enthusiasts and collectors thrilled with the impressive curation of pieces that challenged conceptions of what paper-based art can be. With around 100 domestic and international galleries showcasing everything from sculptures, drawings, paintings, photography and more, the 8th edition of Art on Paper proved yet again why the fair has become known as an important destination for the arts in New York City.

Art on Paper's medium-driven focus has always showcased unique and powerful projects - visual, experiential moments that have continued to set the fair apart since its inception. This year was no different. Visitors comfortably moved around Pier 36's bright, spacious, museum quality set-up, taking in the immense artistry throughout. Highlights included a number of incredible public projects - all presented by women in the arts - which encouraged engagement from visitors with their interactive presentation and immersive constructions: from **Shanthi Chandrasekar's *Entropy: Macrostates & Microstates*** (presented by **LAMINAproject**), which explored the play of light and shadow through an installation of overlapping hole-punched paper leads that created a lace-like effect; to the fantastical environment created by the colorful, textural lively forms of **Yuko Nishikawa's *Memory Tourist*** (presented by **Cynthia Corbett Gallery**); and through **Angiola Churchill's** monumental paper installation ***Labyrinth*** (presented by **Wook+Lattuada**).

Additional key visual moments included **Leah Hewson's** colorful, structural installation titled ***Kin Connection*** (**Stoney Road Press**) which focused on the significance of connection and support, **Bang Geul Han's *Warp and Weft*** (presented by **Accola Griefen Fine Art**), involving a series of hand-woven tapestries constructed from paper printouts of legal documents (from state codes concerning abortion, and anti-immigration memoranda to Supreme Court opinions), and a solo exhibition of works on paper by Atlanta-based Venezuelan-Panamanian artist Lucha Rodriguez (presented by **Paradigm Gallery**).

The success of this year's Art on Paper was recognized by galleries, artists, and buyers alike:
